Competencies Targeted	Evaluation Methods
<b>TALK (Competency 1):</b> Uses language/talk to communicate and to learn – 33.3%	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Participation in group activities and discussions</li><li>• Reflections, self-evaluations</li><li>• Use of research methods</li></ul>
<b>READING (Competency 2):</b> Reads and listens to written, spoken and media texts – 33.3%	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Independent reading (i.e. text selection; attitude/engagement)</li><li>• Interpretation/analysis of texts (e.g. articles of the week responses, literary responses)</li><li>• Use of reading strategies, text annotations</li></ul>
<b>PRODUCTION (Competency 3):</b> Produces texts for personal and social purposes – 33.4%	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Use of Writing notebook (i.e. completion of entries)</li><li>• Use of structures and features, codes and conventions of a variety of text-types (e.g. narrative texts; feature, commentary and opinion articles; reviews)</li><li>• Application of the writing process</li></ul>
<b>At the end of Term 1:</b> Students will write an exam that will count for 20% of their TALK, READING and PRODUCTION <u>term</u> marks.	
<b>At the end of Term 2:</b> Students will complete an Evaluation Situation (ES) that will count for 50% of their overall <u>final</u> TALK, READING and PRODUCTION marks.
