<b>Competency 1:</b> <i>Interprets a contemporary world problem (50%)</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Consolidating knowledge of themes</li><li>• Analyzing sources critically &amp; establishing causal connections</li><li>• Participating in whole class discussions</li><li>• Presentations, projects, mid-term and mid-year assessments</li></ul>	
<b>Competency 2:</b> <i>Takes a position on a contemporary world issue (50%)</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Using a research process &amp; evaluating credible online documents</li><li>• Participating in whole class discussions &amp; one-on-one teacher conferences</li><li>• Writing opinion pieces with evidence</li><li>• Presentations, projects, mid-term and mid-year assessments</li></ul>	
<b>Term 1:</b> By October 15, students will be issued a Progress Report with comments on their learning progress, behaviour and subject-specific competencies. At the end of term, students will be evaluated through class discussions as well as individual and group work. By November 19, students will be issued a Report Card.		
<b>Term 2:</b> Students will write an open-book midyear exam (20%) and also be evaluated through class discussions and individual and group work. By March 15, students will be issued a Report Card.		
<b>Term 3:</b> At the end of term, students will be evaluated based on a long-term research project (60%), class discussions and individual and group work.
